**PSAT & NMSQT** (National Merit Qualifying Test) – **October 11<sup>th</sup> 2017**, ALL SOPHOMORES!

+ any Junior that wants to be considered for the National Merit Scholarship. Deadline to register for NMSQT is October 4<sup>th</sup>. Students must pay \$15 to the registrar in order to sign up to take the NMSQT.

**ASVAB** – Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery- *Offered at Hillcrest on **December 19<sup>th</sup> 2017** at 8:30 am. Interested students can sign up at the College and Career Advising office. There is no charge for this test. There is no obligation for enlistment for students who take this test. Tests can be scheduled monthly with a local recruiter.*

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a multiple choice test, administered by the United States Military Entrance Processing Command, used to determine qualification for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces. **For more information** <http://official-asvab.com/>
